

FREE BUS TRIPS to EDINBURGH

A bus will run from Tweedsmuir and Broughton to Edinburgh and back on the second Saturday of each month from July to October 2015, that is:

- 11 July
- 8 August
- 12 September
- 10 October

The bus will leave Tweedsmuir (Carlowse Bridge) at 9.40 a.m. and Broughton (Shop) at 10 a.m., and will arrive Edinburgh (Waterloo Place) at around 11 a.m. It will return from Edinburgh at 6 p.m., arriving Broughton at around 7 p.m. and Tweedsmuir at 7.15 p.m.

Journeys will be free of charge. You may want to make sure of a seat by getting a ticket in advance, for travel to Edinburgh from either Tweedsmuir or Broughton. These tickets may be obtained from the Broughton shop up to 2 p.m. on the day before travel, upon payment of £1, which will not be refundable and will be retained by the shop. Ticket holders should arrive 5 minutes before departure time. Or you can take your chance and just turn up on the day of travel, when tickets will be issued free of charge on the bus.

Notes:

- The service is provided by Upper Tweed Community Council, with funding from the Infinis Glenkerie Community Fund, using a bus hired from Barc.
- Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
- No special disabled access but the driver will assist people to board when necessary.
- Passengers will be asked to complete a questionnaire on the bus, to help with planning for future years.
- If you are late, the bus will not wait.
- The bus will not stop between Broughton and Edinburgh.
- For those who want to return from Edinburgh earlier in the day, bus no. 101 leaves Edinburgh at 4.20 p.m., arrives Biggar 5.41 p.m., and bus no. 91 leaves Biggar at 6.01 p.m., arrives Broughton 6.13 p.m.
- Passengers from Tweedsmuir may use the service just to travel to Broughton School, from where they can catch the 10.03 a.m. bus no. 91 to Peebles (Eastgate). The last bus back leaves Peebles at 5.20 p.m., arriving Broughton (Shop) shortly after 5.45 p.m., from where the bus back to Tweedsmuir can be picked up later. No tickets will be issued for travel between Tweedsmuir and Broughton.
- Normal fares will be charged on buses no.91 and 101.
- You travel at your own risk. No liability will be assumed by Upper Tweed Community Council if for some reason the bus cannot run as advertised.
