01.05 WELCOME and APOLOGIES

Changes to the procedure associated with the administration of grants approved by TCC were discussed. The importance of applicants reading the eligibility criteria carefully before making an application was highlighted and if in doubt to contact a Community Councillor to discuss, prior to making an application. It was agreed that going forward –

- applicants to the Youth Bursary Fund (aged 12 years and above) to apply on their own behalf
- applicants would be required to be specific and where possible provide evidence of, the costs associated with their grant application e.g. X number of lessons at X amount per lesson, cost of materials X.
- a letter confirming the purpose of the grant, the amount and the need for feedback to TCC would be sent with the grant cheque

GP confirmed that further to the discussions which have taken between Skirling, Upper Tweed and Tweedsmuir TCC's it has been agreed to set up an Endowment Fund for any 'uncommitted' grant monies from the SSE Windfarm.
