- management of flooding issues at Mountbog Discussions are ongoing within SBC as to how this issue will be managed/resolved.
- Closure of B712. There have been several complete closures over the past few months, the most recent with no notice being given, causing disruption to residents, visitors and businesses. Discussions are underway to identify systems for carrying out road repairs that do not require a complete road closure.

- Activities are ongoing to use grants recently awarded. One, primarily to improve the appearance of the old Crook building and improve site security and the second, to further kit out the kitchen and interior of The Wee Crook. Both grants need to be fully spent by March '23.

13.12 Biggar Patient Medical Practice Group

LM reported having recently attended her first meeting, as the representative for Tweedsmuir. The Practice has just been awarded 'Scottish Medical Practice of the Year. There are currently no plans to return to face:face contacts without telephone triage. **LM** had enquired whether a consultation option via zoom might be offered as an alternative to a phone contact, as some may feel more comfortable with this. The Practice agreed to consider this. On occasions when patient demand exceeds capacity the surgery switches to 'urgent care' where only patients with urgent medical needs, as judged by the patient themselves, will be offered an appointment. Anyone registered with the Practice who has issues they wish to be raised at the Practice Group meeting, please contact a Community Councillor.

14.12 Snow blower

A snowblower, for the Village, is kept at Heatherlea, Kirk Road. It can be used by residents who have received training, there is a training form with a checklist signed by the user. The training isn't complicated and doesn't take long. Those who were trained several years ago need to have a quick update. If there's a big fall of snow, it's helpful if anyone in the vicinity can take a turn with road clearing before the snow compacts too much. There are supplies of fuel, snow mitts and safety glasses.
